



FEE SCHEDULE 2021

AFRICA, SOUTH AND SOUTHEAST ASIA

APPLICATION FEE

HFAC charges an Application Fee for operations submitting an application for Initial Certification or Certification Renewal in order to cover administrative costs associated with processing the application. The application fees are as follows:

| Date application submitted | Fee |
|--|----------|
| For new clients or renewals confirmed until 60 days before the anniversary of the last annual inspection | US\$ 120 |
| For renewals confirmed between 60 and 30 days before the anniversary of the last annual inspection | US\$ 240 |
| For renewals confirmed in less than 30 days before the anniversary of the last annual inspection | US\$ 480 |

INSPECTION FEES

Calculated based on time dedicated to inspection visits (standard annual inspections, additional inspections or unannounced inspections). Inspection fees do not include logistic costs (transportation/food/accommodation), which are taken care by the operator.

Farm Inspections: The HFAC fee for conducting inspections of a farm is US\$ 600/day(8hs)/inspector.

Processor, Product Manufacturing Operations (PMO), Pooled Product Operators (PPO), Slaughter and Handling Facility: The HFAC fee for conducting inspections of a PMO, PPO, Processor, Sales Office, Restaurant or Slaughter is US\$750/day(8hs)/facility/inspector. For shorter duration inspections (<8 hs), there is no reduction on the above-mentioned amount.

CERTIFICATION FEES

HFAC certification fees are payable on ALL products that are licensed for sale as Certified Humane® by a certified producer or farm. Therefore, monthly fees (based on the following chart) should be calculated and on all licensed products, regardless of the type of labeling used.

| Young Dairy Beef | \$0,2853 / head |
| Pigs | 1 - 35 thousand animals = \$ 0,2853 / pig 35 - 65 thousand animals = \$ 0,2150 / pig 65 - 100 thousand animals = \$ 0,1605 / pig 100 - 200 thousand animals = \$ 0,1204 / pig 200 - 300 thousand animals = \$ 0,0903 / pig > 300 thousand animals = \$ 0,0677 / pig |
| Broiler Chickens | 1 - 6 million birds = \$ 0,0017 / bird 6 - 15 million birds = \$ 0,0012 / bird 15 - 30 million birds = \$ 0,0009 / bird 30 - 40 million birds = \$ 0,0007 / bird > 40 million birds = \$ 0,0005 / bird |
| Turkeys | \$ 0,0189 / bird |
| Sheep / Lamb | \$ 0,1816 per 1000 liters – for milk \$ 0,1265 / head – for meat |
| Bison | 1 - 500 animals = \$ 0,5105 / head 500 - 2.500 animals = \$ 0,3829 / head > 2.500 animals = \$ 0,2553 / head |

Certified operations must pay certification fees to HFAC on a quarterly basis. At the discretion of the Executive Director, operations may pre-arrange semester or annual payments. Product Manufacturing Operations (PMOs) do not pay certification fees.

DELINQUENT CERTIFICATION FEES

If a certified operator fails to pay certification fees in a timely manner, certification may be suspended.
